Sub: Stoppage of recovery of CCS dues – Reg.

On scrutiny of superannuation pension papers and Last Pay Certificates, it is observed that Co-operative Credit Society (CCS) dues are being shown as outstanding for recovery of the same from DCRG. The number of cases where CCS dues are outstanding is increasing day by day. Recovery of the CCS dues could not be affected in certain cases where society demand letter is received but individual / staff consent letter is not received and vice-a-versa. In some cases CCS dues amount shown as outstanding in LPC and the amount shown in individual consent letter differ. This leads to delay in settlement of pension cases leading to avoidable correspondence with units.

2. Further, it may also be kindly noted that as per Government of India's Decision (GID) (1) under Rule 73 of Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972 "Co-operative societies are not Government Organizations and such any dues to them cannot be treated as dues to Government. No recovery of such dues can be made from the DCRG"

3. In view of the above, it is informed that no outstanding CCS dues can be recovered or withheld from DCRG in respect of superannuation pension cases and showing of any CCS dues as outstanding in LPC and other pension papers may please be avoided. In respect of Family Pension and prematurely retired officials outstanding CCS dues will be recovered from DCRG only if consent letter is submitted along with the pension papers.

4. It is kindly requested to issue instructions accordingly to all BSNL units under AP Circle for implementation of the same. This office can take no action with reference to recovery of outstanding CCS dues in respect of superannuation cases received from September 2013 onwards.
